Free Falling

Trace your hands with a pencil. Then, trace your shoes. Next, draw YOU behind them. What is the *perspective** of your drawing? You could make it look like you are falling... up or down! Are you up high in outer space with the stars and planets or near clouds, birds, and butterflies? Or maybe your perspective is looking down --will you splash into the ocean alongside tropical fish or bounce into a ball pit? Draw details with pencil. Finally, add color with crayons or markers.

*Perspective is the way things are seen from a particular point of view. Example: The perspective from the airplane made everything below look tiny.

Note: if your paper at home is too small, trace just the tops of your feet, or trace only your hands. You may also tape 4 pieces of paper together.
