Fort Banks Programming Hours and Important Dates

Please reference the program dates and times below for your consideration as you plan for your family's logistics during the year.

The first day of school for **ALL Students PreK-2** is Wednesday, August 30th

- Preschool Student Hours - 8:00am - 1:00pm
- **Kindergarten students will attend school daily from 7:40 am-1:40pm**
- **1st and 2nd grade student hours are 7:50 am-2:10 pm Monday-Friday, with the Early release day programming going from 7:50 am -11:00 am**

District Early Release days fall on Wednesdays when scheduled - 10/4 - 12/13 - 1/31 - 3/6 - and 5/8 Please mark these dates on your calendar and plan for your child to be picked up on the appropriate date and time

Elementary half days for parent conferences - October 11th, 18th, 25th- March 27th April 3rd, April 10th

First day school Logistics - Grades 1 and 2 first days of school, Aug 30-31, Family members are encouraged to walk to school, if in a close proximity, where staff will be waiting to receive your child. It is at this hand-off point where adults will say goodbye to their child, outside, as they are escorted into the building. For those families who will be driving, you will use the 'Loop' and will follow the traditional loop procedure. If you are unclear of the loop procedure, I ask that you type this address

Kindergarten First days of school Logistics Logistics**The first day for Kindergarten is Wednesday, August 30th** - On this day, kindergarten students, ONLY, will attend school for an abbreviated transition with one family adult. This visit is intended to provide you and your child the opportunity to meet your teacher in a low-stress environment and to become acquainted with the Fort's arrival and departure protocols. Please plan to park at the cemetery parking lot. walk your child down the sidewalk, onto campus, where you will be directed by Fort staff to assemble outside the school in a marked designated area.

It is important to note that adults will not access the inside of the school to say goodbye to their child. The hand off of your child will take place outside; thank you so much

Breakfast Option at The Fort - The Fort banks and food service staff will serve breakfast starting at 7:20 AM in the cafeteria, daily. Students who want to participate in our morning breakfast program should enter through the front door of the Fort Banks, where they will be greeted and welcomed into the building. School Provided Meals - All school meals (lunch and breakfast) will continue to be served *free* of charge again this year for all students. Snacks should be brought from home. Students are usually hungry by recess, so a healthy snack is important. Your teacher can give you guidance on this. Any/all families in need should fill out a free/reduced lunch form provided by the business office online or pick up one at the Fort Banks, If a family qualifies, there are other benefits available.

Daily Student Wrap-Around Support

Kindergarten students will attend school from 7:40 a.m.-1:40 p.m. Students that have siblings in multiple grades that are impacted by the difference in kindergarten and first/second grade start/end times, and only those students, are eligible to attend the morning and afternoon wrap-around program. This program provides student supervision to ease the arrival/dismissal challenges of these families. Please contact the school's Administrative Assistant, to enroll in this option.

Label Students' Belongings - Please

Please take a few moments to label your child's belongings. For example, backpacks, coats, lunch boxes, even shoes should be clearly labeled. We will designate an area for lost and found early in the year, but it is much easier to return it to the child that day.

Fort Security

For security purposes when school is in session, everybody (parent/caregivers and other visitors) MUST check-in at the office and obtain a Visitor's Pass. Please have an ID ready as well. If you plan to volunteer at the Fort, a CORI (criminal record check) is required. You can access a CORI form in the main office or on the [GFB website](#), under the , '[For Parents](#)' link. We will no longer require proof of vaccination for our visitors.
