

In this newsletter you will find snapshots of activities and events during the winter, depicting a multitude of accomplishments reflecting the academic, community and extracurricular successes of our students and staff.

Thirty-five students were inducted in the National Honor Society, joining the twenty-seven second year members. The WHS Drama Society returned to Prince Pizzeria for an outstanding dinner theater performance, celebrating their 20<sup>th</sup> year. WHS Drama also performed "Woven" written by WHS junior Chelsea Long, at the preliminary round of the METG Drama Festival, receiving several awards. WMS Drama Society put on an outstanding performance of "The Lion King, Jr." WMS Quiz Bowl Team, the only public school competing in the Quiz Bowl Competition at Malden Catholic, took 3<sup>rd</sup> Place!

WHS Boys' Hockey are the 2025 MIAA Division 4 State Champions! Boys' and Girls' Hockey are CO-NEC Champions. Isabella Rice and Zoey Ray qualified for States in Gymnastics in the Bars Event and the Gymnastics Team also qualified for States finishing in 9<sup>th</sup> Place. Isabella Rice also made the Nationals Team for Gymnastics, which is the top 20 girls in the State of Massachusetts. She is the 5<sup>th</sup> gymnast from WHS to make the team and will compete in Fort Myers in May. Track superstar Aaron Armistead qualified for States in Hurdles.

I continue to be amazed at the talent and positive spirit of students and the never-ending support of our families, staff and community. I hope you enjoy our winter newsletter!





# **Throw Back**



OLD POINT SHIRLEY SCHOOL HOUSE - JUST BEFORE BEING DEMOLISHED IN FEBRUARY 1932

The Point Shirley School House was on the corner of Shirley Street and Siren Street. It was built in 1856, the same year as our first town hall, by builder George Shaw, costing \$635.00.

The Schoolhouse was demolished in February, 1932.



The Pauline Street School was built in 1881 and originally had four rooms. It was expanded in 1887, doubling its size and adding a clock tower. It was destroyed by a fire in 1905. The E.B. Newton Grammar School was built in it's place.




