- 1. Choose a project that is within your capabilities.
- 2. Show up, on time, and being willing to work.
- 3. Wear appropriate attire for the work you are doing.
- 4. Limited phones, you should be working during your community service.
- 5. In the event you cannot make your scheduled time you need to reach out to the adult supervisor. It is your responsibility to then reschedule and coordinate hours.
- 6. Have a plan, scheudle the dates and times of your hours, this is your responsibility to fit your community service into your schedule. You need to be clear with the adult supervisor about what works for you and what does not work for you. Don't wait until the last minute, and have some back up dates just in case.
- 7. Behave accordingly. If you behave in a manor that is unbecoming, or you are bailing out on your scheduled time last minute, and your adult sepervisors asks you to leave, and does not want to continue to have you, that is on you, and you will have to figure something out.
