## Participation Rubric

Students will receive a point value between 60 and 100 for monthly participation grades.

90-100 - Student is focused on the lesson and is volunteering for an activity or to answer a question. They are respectful of other classmates and are following all class rules. They have completed tasks/assignments to the best of their ability. They do not use cell phones during class.

80-89- Student is focused on the lesson for a majority (or all) of the time but has not volunteered to answer a question or participate in a game or activity. They have completed most (or all) of the assignment to the best of their ability. They may have been spoken to regarding respecting other classmates or following class rules. They have been asked to put cell phone away.

70-79- Student is not focused on the lesson. They do not volunteer to answer questions or participate in activities or they have been spoken to more then once regarding disrespect towards a classmate or class rule. They have completed only a small portion of the assignment/task. They have been asked more than once to put cell phone away.

60-69 - Student is not focused on the lesson and is distracting others from the task at hand. They have been asked to leave a class due to breaking a class rule or using cell phone excessively. They did not complete any task at hand while in the classroom.
