<b>Treasurer</b>	The treasurer of Winthrop High School's chapter of the National Honor Society is required to collect and keep track of member's dues, keep a balance of expenditures, proof read documents, and help inventory to determine purchasing.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be a second year member</li> <li>• Help with the running of the chapter</li> <li>• Collect, keep track, and be responsible for member's due's payments</li> <li>• Keep a register of the chapter's expenditures (what we spend money on)</li> <li>• Help with inventory to dictate buying and purchasing for the chapter</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Give a speech on one of the four pillars of the National Honor Society; character, leadership, scholarship, and service</li> <li>• Receive treasurer insignia at ceremony</li> </ul>
